



What's New for U-Permit Application Customers

Updated September, 2023

September 2023

- Street Damage Restoration Fees section has been updated.
 - If you would like to pay the SDRF fee, application fee, or construction management traffic fee before permit issuance, you are able to change the radio buttons to yes for each.
 - Staff will then be able to generate invoices for each item. Customers will get an email upon invoice generation.

March 2022

- Technical assistance has migrated to the Customer Service Request System (check if U-permit is hyphenated)
- Resetting a customer's password will send an email notification to the email address associated with the account
- Implemented ordinance update for [LAMC 62.06](#)* SDRF Small Excavations and Sewer Laterals
 - Added a "Small/Isolated Cut" button to the cuts section of the application to account for the ordinance update
- Deployed Job Sqft changes:
 - Job square footage is computed from GIS cuts drawn by the customer
 - This is not editable by staff or customers
 - For micro-trench, this calculation is based on 1ft wide trench
 - For Regular Cuts/Small Cuts this calculation is done by adding all the square footage. The five feet buffer sqft will not be considered

*This ordinance removes the 5' influence area for cuts that do not exceed 4' in either dimension, and also for cuts for sewer lateral repairs.

January 2022

- An error message will display if a document is uploaded with a filename that is too long
- Clarification text has been added under the job square footage item within the “Review Permit” screen
